

Questions and Answers for JJCC/JPCF Request for Proposals

Q 1. Can our proposed program serve youth who are "at-risk" of becoming involved or who have been involved with the juvenile justice system, or only youth who are currently on Probation?

A 1. For JPCF funding, the program can be for any of the populations mentioned above. For JJCPA funding, the primary focus is on youth who are already in the juvenile justice system.

Q 2. On page 13 of the RFP it states that the "length of the proposal narrative should not exceed 14 pages", yet does not specify which sections of the proposal are considered part of the "proposal narrative". Does this page limit apply to all sections covered in Tab 1 through Tab 8 or only specific sections in certain tabs?

A 2. The page limit applies to Tabs 1 through 6.

Q 3. Do exhibits and enclosures need to be completed?

A 3. On page 16 of the RFP there are three enclosures listed: Agreement, Matrix, and Ordinance Code. The sample agreement is for information only and the exhibits attached to the agreement do not need to be completed. As for the enclosures, the only one that needs to be included with your RFP packet is the Budget Matrix.
